

OAFF Scholarship Program

An Investment in the Future of Oklahoma

The OAFF is committed to promoting education in the lives of Oklahoma's youth. The OAFF Scholarship Program provides this opportunity to seniors graduating from high school and attending an Oklahoma college or university in the fall. The purpose of the scholarship is to:

- Encourage students to continue their educational development
- Recognize the overall achievements of the students
- Ensure the longevity of the OAFF and all fairs, festivals and events through support of Oklahoma youth
- Award one meritorious student in each of the four OAFF districts a \$500 scholarship to be used toward tuition, books and other school fees.

Applicant Eligibility

- Applicants County Fair or Jr. Livestock Show must be a current member in good standing with the OAFF
- Applicant must live within the geographical boundaries of the submitting County Fair/Jr. Livestock Show
- Applicant must be an active member in good standing of Oklahoma 4H or FFA
- Applicant must have participated in fair competitive events
- Applicant must graduate from high school during the year of application, and enroll in their chosen college or university the following fall semester
- Applicant must attend an accredited Oklahoma college or university
- Applicant must be a United States citizen and a legal resident of the State of Oklahoma

Application Requirements

- Applicant must have an Agricultural Science Teacher or County Extension agent furnish a statement regarding fair competitive events in which the applicant participated, including the active years of participation
- Applicant must provide college entrance test scores for ACT or SAT
- Applicant must provide an official transcript(through the fall semester of the senior year), class size and rank in class
- Applicant must provide two letters of recommendation
- Interviews may or may not be required
- A current photograph must be attached to the application
- Only current application forms will be accepted and considered
- ALL APPLICATIONS MUST BE SUBMITTED NO LATER THAN JANUARY 10, 2012

Application Process

Pre-selected by County Fair or Jr. Livestock Show

Meet all OAFF Scholarship Program requirements

Complete the three page application

Deliver completed application to your County Fair or Jr. Livestock Show representative by the date on file with your county. Check with your County Extension Agent or Ag teacher for additional information.

County Fairs or Jr. Livestock Shows will select and submit their representative to the OAFF Scholarship Committee

The awards will be sent directly to the institution after proof of enrollment is received and no later than the withdrawal date of record for that institution.

ALL APPLICATIONS MUST BE SUBMITTED NO LATER THAN JANUARY 10, 2012.
